* four applicants will also be allowed to present their ongoing research during the Workshop. Interested participants are invited to submit a proposal for a presentation (20 mins+discussion, max 250 words), that will be evaluated by the Organizing Committee.

LETiSS will book an accommodation for 10 selected applicants and cover their accommodation expenses.
